CONTROVERSY CAUSED BY THE REQUEST TO REMOVE THE STATUE OF SAINT MICHEL IN SABLE DOLONNE IN THE NAME OF SECULARISM

Indeed, last December 16, the administrative court of Nantes, seized by the Federation of Vendée of the "Free thought", ordered the municipality of Sables d'Olonne to unbolt within six months the statue of the Archangel Saint- Michel. Previously this statute was exhibited in a private school which was destroyed, it was then installed recently on the forecourt of the church of the same name. The "Free Thought of Vendée", which intends to enforce the neutrality of the public service with regard to cults, considers that this religious emblem does not respect the 1905 law on secularism. Faced with this appeal deemed "abusive" by Yannick Moreau, the mayor of Sables d'Olonnes, the town appealed against the decision. "This affair aroused a legitimate emotion, and our statue has indeed become a national issue and symbol", indicates the city councilor who intends not to remain passive while awaiting the verdict which could intervene in several years.

It is therefore in this context that Eric Zemmour and Philippe de Villiers, went to the town hall of Les Sables, where a private interview was scheduled with the mayor Yannick Moreau (various right-wing and Les Républicains until 2017). The candidate Eric Zemmour for the Presidency of the Republic and his main supporter in the Pays de la Loire, went there to defend the maintenance of the statue of the Archangel Saint Michael, a religious symbol whose Judeo-Christian roots they claim. This is why they took a walkabout around this statue of Saint Michael, the subject of great controversy, for which the administrative court requested the withdrawal of public space a few weeks ago.
